Croatia Deakin Soccer Club is a not-for-profit, community-based organisation that complies with its obligations under the *Gaming Machine Act 2004*. The Club's community contributions are directed toward activities that provide a clear and measurable benefit to the ACT community and align with the permitted community purpose categories under section 172 of the Act.

As outlined in the accompanying Community Contributions spreadsheet for the 2024–2025 reporting period, Croatia Deakin Soccer Club has contributed amounts that exceed the minimum required contribution level. Contributions have been made across multiple eligible community purpose categories.

Participation in Sport and Recreation

The Club's primary community contribution is the ongoing support and development of soccer within the ACT. This includes significant investment in:

- Croatia FC senior men's programs
- Women's football, supporting participation, equity and development pathways
- Junior football programs, providing structured, inclusive and development-focused opportunities for children and young people

These activities support increased participation in organised sport and promote physical health, wellbeing and social connection.

Education, Culture and Social Inclusion

The Club also supports eligible community activities outside of football, including:

- Toastmasters, supporting education, communication skills and lifelong learning
- Probus, promoting social engagement, wellbeing and continued learning for seniors
- HFS Croatian Dancing, supporting cultural participation, heritage preservation and community engagement

In addition, Croatia Deakin Soccer Club provides facilities for use by more than 11 community clubs and groups, supporting social inclusion, multicultural participation and community cohesion.

Commitment to Community Benefit

The Club applies gaming machine revenue responsibly and transparently to ensure contributions deliver genuine community benefit. The breadth and value of contributions recorded in the spreadsheet demonstrate that Croatia Deakin Soccer Club exceeds its statutory community contribution obligations and remains committed to supporting the ACT community.
